

Nampa's sign regulations are found in Chapter 10.23 of the Nampa Municipal Code. This brochure summarizes the regulations for permanent signs.

Standards address when and for how long signs may be displayed, sign location, the number of signs, size, height, and sign design.

Signs in the public right-of-way in violation of the standards of the code will be removed by the City of Nampa and may be discarded.

Violators of the sign code are subject to citation and fines.
